Principal Duties and Responsibilities:

- Diagnostic hearing evaluations
- Develop and implement personalized treatment plans, including fitting, programming, and verifying hearing devices and other hearing solutions
- Perform real-ear verification and evidence-based practices to ensure optimal hearing device outcomes
- Provide ongoing support to patients by providing counseling and education to patients and their families on hearing health, device care, and communication strategies
- At least 3 years of hearing aid fitting and dispensing experience preferred but not required
- Complete timely documentation
- Participate heavily in community outreach, educational events, or marketing initiatives to promote hearing health awareness and growth of the practice.
- Stay current with advancements in audiology through continuing education and professional development
- Contribute to the smooth operation of the practice, including assisting with administrative tasks and workflow improvements as needed
